Multi-Term Contract
#18-52MB Shade Structures

The award of contracts under this Bid will result in a multi-term contract to cover a period not to exceed five (5) years. In accordance with School District Procurement Rules R7-2-1093, before the use of a multi-term contract, the Governing Board must make a written determination that it is appropriate to do so. In accordance with Mesa Public Schools Governing Board Policy DJA adopted by the Governing Board on May 27, 2008, the Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent of Business and Support Services and Director of Purchasing have been delegated authority by the Governing Board to make this written determination.

Therefore, the following written determination is made that it is advantageous to the District to utilize a multi-term contract for this solicitation for the following reasons:

1. The estimated requirements cover the period of the contracts and are reasonable and continuing.
2. The use of the subsequent multi-term contracts will serve the best interests of the school district by encouraging effective competition or otherwise promoting economies of scale in school district procurement.
3. If monies are not appropriated or otherwise made available to support continuation of performance in a subsequent fiscal period, the contract shall be canceled and the contractor may only be reimbursed for the reasonable value of any nonrecurring costs incurred but not amortized in the price of the materials or services delivered under the contract or which are otherwise not recoverable. The cost of cancellation may be paid from any appropriations available for such purposes.

For these reasons, it is advantageous to the District to enter into a contract for a period of up to five (5) years as allowed by the School District Procurement Code. The solicitation shall include the term of contract and conditions of renewal or extension.
